
END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT (EULA) SOFTWARE UPDATE FOR CUSTOMERS

What is changing?

Capstone is changing the way we store and check against the End User License Agreement (EULA) your school or your district has agreed to. The language of the agreement has been updated, and some technical details of how we store the EULA agreements have been adjusted. You may notice a few changes:

PebbleGo & PebbleGo Next

If you can currently access a Pebble database

You have accepted the Pebble EULA and won't need to take any action.

If you add another Pebble database to an existing product (PebbleGo or PebbleGo Next)

You would previously have had to accept another EULA. Now you won't have to!

If you're accessing a trial version of Pebble Go or Pebble Go Next

You will need to comply with the EULA, but you will not have to take action beyond signing up for the trial. After the trial, you will need to accept the EULA again.

Capstone Interactive

If your students primarily access CI titles via MARC records.

You'll want to make sure that you have an accepted EULA on file. To check this, log into CI using your building or district administrator credentials. If you do not have a EULA on file, you will be asked to accept the EULA. You won't be able to take any further action within CI (nor will your students) until the EULA has been accepted.

If you have accepted the EULA

You won't see any changes.

If you're accessing a trial version of CI

You will need to comply with the EULA but you don't need to take action beyond logging in. After the trial, you will need to accept the EULA again.
