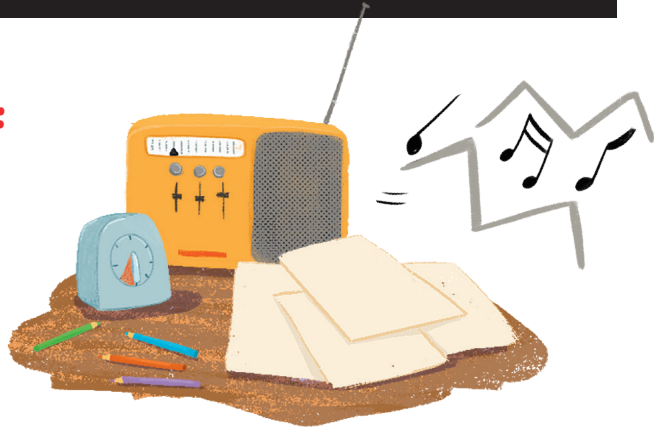


# QUICK DRAW MUSIC!

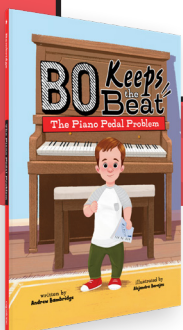
## WHAT YOU NEED:

- a timer
- a radio or smart speaker
- colored pencils, crayons, or markers
- 4 pieces of paper



## WHAT YOU DO:

1. Ask a grown-up if they have a radio or music streaming service you can use.
2. Pick a station or song at random—any music!
3. Set your timer for 30 or 60 seconds.
4. Draw a picture that you think goes with the song you hear playing. Is it slow or fast? Happy or sad? What colors or shapes does it make you want to draw?
5. When the timer goes off, find a different song. Set your timer again and draw another picture on the second sheet of paper.
6. Repeat two more times until you have four pictures.
7. Display your pictures and ask your family if they can tell what kind of music goes with each picture you drew.
